This session will focus on the implementation of PBIS – Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports in a high school setting. School-wide PBIS is a systems approach to discipline that emphasizes prevention, social skills instruction and data-based decision-making to reduce problem behavior and improve academic performance. Participants will discover how St. Cloud Area School District 742 developed their PBIS program. Ideas and specific strategies will be shared on how to begin the PBIS process and create a more positive learning environment.

Kevin J. Filter, Ph.D., is an associate professor of school psychology at Minnesota State University, Mankato, who has served in Minnesota as a PBIS trainer and state PBIS leadership team member. Charles Eisenreich is the principal at St. Cloud Apollo High School. Eisenreich serves on the Minnesota State PBIS leadership team as a statewide presenter and trainer for new schools implementing PBIS and is the chairperson of the district PBIS leadership team in the St. Cloud school district.
